Streetscape update	<p>Bridget S.-D.said soon the reconfiguration work at the intersection at Kilpatrick and Byron will be begin. Traffic will be limited to southbound only on Kilpatrick between Irving and Milwaukee. Work is finishing up on the sidewalk and vault work on the east side of Milwaukee. The Milwaukee side of the vault work will be done in about a week and a half, the Cicero will take until about the end of April.</p> <p>Bridget S-D. said work will start at the Six Corners intersection in June with the north side of Irving west of Cicero and west side of Cicero north of Irving. Left turns will be prohibited on southbound and northbound Cicero through end May 1. During work on Irving, parking will be prohibited on the work side of the street. During work on Cicero, parking will be prohibited on both sides.</p> <p>Over the next couple of weeks, the pedestrian light poles will go up on Milwaukee. Bridget left at this time.</p> <p>Vince M. asked about parking alternatives at Bank of America. Two-way street issue	<p>We heard two weeks ago from Marlene Raddatz at Ald. Levar's office. She is waiting to hear back from Walgreens on whether it will fund the work on Belle Plaine. John A. reported that Dunkin' Donuts says he's waiting for the weather but should happen within the next weeks or months. The committee agreed to write a letter to the alderman about Walgreens. Joe A. suggested that the letter could point out that the expense of maintaining the commercial lightpoles, which they committed when they got their driveway permits, is gone with the streetscape.</p> <p>The committee also agreed to meet at 4 p.m., Wednesday, April 21 to review the kiosk proposals.</p>	Write letter to alderman.
