Building improvement grants

Drastically cut your up-front costs. The SBIF program will pay for up to 75% of your build-out costs. It covers any changes you make to a building such as plumbing, electric, roof and storefront. The association can help you facilitate this process with city agencies and the alderman's office.

Façade Assistance Program

The Six Corners Association will help you design your new storefront. An architect will review your façade needs and provide a rendering for you that you can show to sign designers and general contractors to best convey your vision.

All businesses should let their customers know when they are open. A uniform open sign is provided to Six Corners businesses, so it's easy to tell for any customer walking or driving by.



Sidewalk and landscape maintenance

Focus on running your business. Daily sidewalk litter pick-up is provided year round. Snow removal is provided in the winter. Landscapers maintain the flowers, planters and provide weed control.
