Approval of minutes	Nick T. made a motion to approve the minutes of the Oct. 2, 2007, Design Committee and Ed B. seconded it.	The minutes were approved without changes.
Illinois Main Street rendering	A proposed rendering from the Illinois Historic Preservation Agency as part of the Illinois Main Street program was reviewed. The rendering was Villa Roma Hair Designers. It was noted that this is a free service provided by IHPA because the association is a member of the Illinois Main Street. Villa Roma can use this rendering to help redesign its storefront – either using the design exactly as submitted or picking design elements from the rendering.	The rendering was filed.
Streetlight holiday decorations	The holiday decorations have been ordered and will be installed later this month.	NA
Storefront windows	A window painter recently decorated a window at Today's Avon. It was suggested that this painter could decorate windows all over Six Corners. In addition to the decorations hanging from the poles, the painting would give the district a unified look. The committee agreed to budget \$1,000 to paint about 25 storefronts.	Contact the painter.
Laporte lot signage	A Laporte lot signage proposal has been changed to changing out the 4x8 foot plywood signs at the entrance. The committee estimated it would cost \$500-\$1,000.	Talk to Dept. of Rev. about changing signs.
Streetscape	The city has the detailed response to the 90% plans but there has been no response. But the city wants our kiosk plans.	Determine content for backs of information kiosks.
